- A personal commitment to Christ – authentically growing in your relationship with Him (growing to a Fully Devoted Follower of Christ).
 - Growing in Discipleship (loving God) – prayer, devotions, obedience.
 - Growing in Fellowship (loving God's family) – serving, connecting.
 - Growing in Mission (loving the lost, needy and hurting) – sharing your faith, serving.
- Regular attendance on Sunday mornings, and supporting the mission, staff and programs of Covenant Grove.
- A willingness to share God's love and your faith with those you are serving. A biblical model of Christian behavior in your actions, speech, faith, and attitude.
- Faithful and consistent in keeping the commitments for ministry and the people you are serving.
